

Walking Tour Details:

Thank you for your interest in a walking tour at Penobscot Marine Museum.

Please arrive promptly at the time of your tour. No need to arrive early. You may park in the main parking lot behind Old Vestry. You will meet your tour guide next to the Camera Obscura ([see campus map](#)). Your tour will last approximately 45 minutes.

We are excited to offer this new way of visiting the Penobscot Marine Museum! To help make your visit enjoyable and safe for everyone involved, please read over the guidelines below.

- PMM staff will greet you with face coverings and wear them whenever in public spaces or group settings on our campus.
- Tour guides will have hand sanitizer available, will maintain 6 feet of distance, and will conduct the tours in outdoor areas and well-ventilated buildings.
- If you or someone in your household has symptoms of COVID-19 or a confirmed case of COVID-19, or if you or someone in your household has been in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19, please cancel your reservation. Refunds are easy and available.
- Bring and wear a face covering for the duration of the tour, per Maine Executive Order 49 FY 19/20.
- Maintain 6 feet between your household and anyone else.
- The entrance to the boat barns is across a grassy area with uneven ground. Old Town Hall is not wheelchair accessible. Our tour guides will adapt the tour to your needs.
- Exhibit buildings are limited to one household at a time. Please follow posted instructions and the instructions of your tour guide.
- There are no bathrooms open to the public during this tour
- Tours run rain or shine. If the weather is bad on the day of your scheduled tour, you will have the option to reschedule or refund.
